

WATER QUALITY AGREEMENT

(To be mailed to the Forest Service office that administers your recreational residence permit.)

NOTICE IS HEREBY given to inform the public and all interested parties, that on the parcel designated as Assessor's Parcel Number: _____ - _____ - _____, as noted in the Official Records of the County of El Dorado, a land use constraint exists. This parcel is also identified as Lot ____ of the _____ Recreation Residence Tract of the Eldorado National Forest.

If in the future there is any evidence of a failure of my existing pit privy or sewage disposal system, or additional information indicates that there is a water quality contamination issue, such as the surface discharge of gray water, I hereby agree to abate the conditions creating the contamination. I fully understand that abatement will include one or more of the following, based on my specific site conditions, and subject to review and approval by the El Dorado County Environmental Management Department and the Eldorado National Forest:

- 1) Repair of my existing system.
- 2) Installation of a newly engineered sewage disposal system.
- 3) Installation of an approved vault system.
- 4) Installation of an approved composting toilet or other approved technology.

I understand that in the event that repair or replacement of an existing pit privy or sewage disposal system is needed, the system must be properly designed and engineered by a licensed professional, installed under permit by the El Dorado County Environmental Management Department and have prior approval by the Eldorado National Forest.

I agree that this statement shall be binding upon the heirs, assigns, and successors in interest of the grantors, and shall remain in effect until rescinded by El Dorado County Environmental Management.
