**OPEN FORUM:**

- Roger- Lions Club Grand Opening – Sat. 1-9. Note: Senior luncheons resume April 20<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Board of Supervisors is considering closing the senior day care and congregate lunch centers due to budget constraints.
- Sheriff D'Agostini – introduced Brent Collins to give the CAC an overview of the current status of a new Public Safety Center to include the Sheriff's Dept., OES, etc. Over 400 sites were identified initially and that has been narrowed down to 3 possible sites. The county is currently in escrow for a site off Industrial Road in the Missouri Flat area.. The goal is "cost containment".

**TOPICS:**

1. **Vehicle/pedestrian issues in El Dorado, Hwy 49 and Pleasant Valley Rd.- Don Spear of El Dorado County DOT and Clark Peri of Caltrans.**
  - a. 2 current programs.
    - i. Starting June 1<sup>st</sup> there will be overlay work on Hwy 49 from the Amador County Line to the town of El Dorado
    - ii. A currently unfunded project is planned for overlay treatment from south of El Dorado to Coon Hollow Road.

b. DOT has a 3-5 year maintenance plan – last year they received \$2.5 million, this year they will have \$1.25, which will allow for a focus on the El Dorado, Diamond Springs area for road enhancement work (resurface Patterson Drive & Pleasant Valley from Oriental to the “Y”).

i. Caltrans is looking into painting "ladder" type crosswalk markings on their crosswalks to match those on El Dorado County Department of Transportation...

**2. Diamond Villa Assisted Living facility located at Fowler/Panther Lane.**

Ron Regan brought approved building plans for project approved prior to the recession. They will consist of a State Licensed Facility of 50 units, whose occupants' age will average 83. They need to have work begun by March 19, 2016. They will be starting with improvements to the intersection with Panther and will need an acceptable level of occupancy before they can begin Phase II which will include a memory care unit.
