- Action Text:** A motion was made by Supervisor Dupray, seconded by Supervisor Santiago to direct staff to:
1. Work with Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) to prepare a detailed scope of work for preparation of a conservation plan which initially provides for a combined Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan/Habitat Conservation Plan/Natural Community Conservation Plan (INRMP/HCP/NCCP); said scope of work shall include:
 - a. planning area to be covered by the plan, including the potential inclusion of federal land;
 - b. impact analysis needed for a HCP/NCCP;
 - c. steps necessary to get a planning agreement with state and federal agencies;
 - d. timelines when the County can determine whether to proceed with a HCP/NCCP or proceed with a local INRMP; and
 - e. structure of citizen participation, including role of the Plant and Wildlife Technical Advisory Committee (PAWTAC).
 2. Formally contact local governmental bodies such as El Dorado Irrigation District, Public Utility Districts, Water Agency, Community Services Districts, and coordinate with California Fish and Game and the Fish and Wildlife Service and seek their input regarding the process and their participation.
 3. Provide scope of work to the Board and the public no later than December 12, 2006. Set a public hearing on January 23, 2007 to review and discuss the scope of work.

Development Services recommending the Board review the responses to comments received on January 23, 2007 regarding the proposed scope of work for the Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan (INRMP) and provide staff with any further direction regarding revisions to the scope; and authorize the Department to commence contract negotiations with Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) and prepare a contract and revised scope of work for consideration by the Board in April/May 2008, after the planned joint session with the El Dorado Irrigation District (EID) Board of Directors.

Background: On January 23, 2007, the Board of Supervisors conducted a public workshop to discuss and to receive comment about the proposed Work Plan, Schedule, and Budget for the El Dorado County Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan. After lengthy discussion and public input, the Board directed Development Services staff to work with Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) to prepare a written response to all of the questions raised by the Board, work with EID staff to schedule a joint session of the Board of Supervisors and the El Dorado Irrigation District Board of Directors, obtain Planning Commission comments, and to follow-up with agencies that did not respond to our original request to invite statements of interest in participating in the INRMP process.

Discussion:

Development Services staff has prepared a consolidated list of comments received from the Board and the public on January 23, 2007. The Department, working together with SAIC, has prepared responses to these comments for further consideration. A primary focus of the Board's comments was the organization of the project relative to the various committees, management team, Planning Commission, and Board. The Board was also interested in better defining opportunities for input and key policy decision making points. Other important points of comment focused on selection of the planning area, baseline mapping, and how the mapping will ultimately be used in connection with the permit review processes. Further comments centered on cost controls, management reporting relationship to the "off-ramp" decision points, and a request for further discussion of various permitting options (e.g. Section 2081, 404, 401 options). Responses to these comments are included in Attachment 1.

Development Services staff is coordinating with El Dorado Irrigation staff and the Board Chair to identify possible dates for the joint session of the Board of Supervisors and the EID Board of Directors. At the time of writing this report the date and time of the joint session were not yet determined.

On February 8, 2007, Development Services staff, during Departmental Reports, provided the Planning Commission with the packet presented to the Board for the January 23, 2007, workshop. The Planning Commission was invited to provide comments concerning the INRMP Work Plan, Schedule, and Budget pursuant to the direction of the Board. The Planning Commission decided to place the item on its February 22, 2007, Agenda for discussion and action. Any comments received from the Planning Commission will be provided to your Board in a separate supplemental packet prior to March 6.

Finally, Development Services staff contacted, by email, all agencies that did not originally respond to the letter signed by the CAO, dated December 22, 2006. As of the date of writing this report we have not received any responses. Development Services staff will provide the Board with any additional agency responses received prior to the March 6, 2007 meeting.

Development Services staff and SAIC will be available to review the information provided to you in this report and respond to any further questions you may have concerning the proposed Work Plan. Dr. Paul Cylinder will be in attendance and will lead the presentation.

As a separate agenda item originated by County Counsel, staff is requesting that the Board authorize County Counsel to enter into a contract with outside counsel (Ebbin, Moser & Skaggs) to provide "as needed" support for contract negotiations and the INRMP process.
