

**Connections One Stop Employment Resource Center** connects employment and training services to businesses, employers, and job seekers in El Dorado and Alpine County. **Connections One Stop Centers** are located in Placerville and South Lake Tahoe.

### WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT

W.I.A. offers a range of workforce development activities to eligible adults, dislocated workers, and youth to promote an increase in the employment, job retention, earnings, and occupational skills of the participants.

#### ADULT AND DISLOCATED WORKER:

For those who need help returning to work or are unlikely to return to their previous industry or occupation. Provides up to \$8,000 for vocational or technical training, and other support services. Displaced homemakers and self-employed individuals may also qualify. Applicant must meet minimum requirements such as:

- Age 18 or older
- Unemployed or underemployed
- Able to be self supporting while in training

#### YOUTH SERVICES:

To assist income-eligible youth in preparing for additional education, vocational training, and/or employment. Applicants must meet minimum requirements such as:

- Between the ages of 17 and 21
- Have an obstacle to employment
