



El Dorado County Tree Removal Program for Low-Income Seniors



Do you have dead or dying trees that are threatening your home? If you are the property owner and are age 60 or older, you may qualify for financial assistance to remove the trees. The funding is available through El Dorado County with a grant from the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CALFIRE). **The grant funding is limited** and available to El Dorado County homeowners who meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Household must be low-income as defined by household size



See Maximum Household Income Limits

- Residence must be properly permitted and owner-occupied by person(s) at least 60 years of age
- Property must be in tree mortality high hazard areas
- Affected trees within 300 feet of an inhabited dwelling must be determined to pose a threat to structure by a professional Forester/Arborist (provided by the County)
- Program allows for removal of two dead/dying trees that pose a threat per eligible property
- Mobilehome Park Residents are not eligible
