

New Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

15 new electric vehicle (EV) charging stations are now operational in the Building B, C and SLT Johnson Center parking lots. 10 stations are at Building B, 4 in SLT and 1 additional charger at Building C. These stations were funded by a California Energy Commission grant and are available for public, County vehicle and staff use. A generic access code is required to activate the chargers at Buildings B and in at the SLT government center. The generic access code is: charger number #, charger number four times #. For example to activate charger number 7 enter 7#7777#. Depress the numbers on the keypad completely so that the green light flashes each time a key is pressed. Plug in your car just before or within 2 minutes and 30 seconds of activating. To get a personal PIN, email your contact information to aqmd@edcgov.us. Your PIN will be assigned and emailed to you within two business days.

If you've been considering purchasing or leasing an EV, now could be a good time to do so.
