- **We are working on:**

Bringing the El Dorado County Ordinance No. 4190, Clean Indoor Air & Health Protection Ordinance (Chapter 8.60 of Title 8), into compliance with State Law.



We Have An Opportunity

- **To include more into our ordinance:**
 - Reducing exposure to secondhand smoke, tobacco smoke residue, tobacco waste, and other tobacco products
 - Reducing the availability of tobacco

Chapter 8.60. – Clean **Indoor** Air and Health Protection

OPTIONS

Smokefree Outdoor Air

- Dining
- Entryways
- Public Events
- Recreation Areas
- Service Areas
- Sidewalks
- Worksites

Smokefree Housing

- Nonsmoking multiunit housing
- Nonsmoking common areas

Emerging Product Definition – Secondhand Smoke

- Prohibit the use of any tobacco product, including electronic smoking devices.
- Prohibit the use of cannabis.

Chapter 8.70. – Prohibition on Sale of Tobacco Products **from Vending Machines**

OPTIONS

Reducing Sales of Tobacco Products

- Tobacco Retail Licensing
- Retailer Location Restrictions
- Sale of Tobacco Products in Pharmacies
- Flavored Tobacco Products
