### Objectives:

*At the conclusion of this course, attendees will be able to:*

1. Demonstrate insertion of orotracheal and stoma intubation with difficult airway pearls and techniques in utilizing associated airway adjuncts (ETTI).
2. Demonstrate insertion of emergency back-up airways to include supraglottic airways, needle cricothyroidotomy.
3. Demonstrate performing 12-lead EKG's, transcutaneous pacing, defibrillation, and synchronized cardioversion.
4. *Demonstrate intraosseous placement sites, demonstration placement of IO needles, and discuss pearls of infusions via IO.*
