

## **Arguments for/against measures N, P, Q, R, S – November 6, 2018**

Arguments for and against these measures may be submitted between the dates of Monday, July 23, 2018 and Friday, July 27, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. Primary arguments for and against these measures shall not exceed 300 words in length and shall not be accepted unless accompanied by the name(s) and address(es) of the person(s) submitting them. Person turning in an argument MUST be a registered voter in the county. No more than five signatures shall appear with any argument and original signatures are necessary.

Rebuttal arguments for or against said measure must be submitted no later than Thursday, August 2, 2018. Rebuttal arguments shall not exceed 250 words in length and follow the same laws as primary arguments with regard to names, signatures and argument submission. All arguments and rebuttals must be submitted in person, or by certified mail to the Registrar of Voters, Elections Department, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA 95667. ### **Measure N (Countywide):**

To provide revenue for general government services, such as law enforcement and public health education, shall the measure regulating and imposing a general tax on any independently authorized commercial cannabis activity in the unincorporated areas of El Dorado County at rates up to: \$30 per square foot or 15% for cultivation; 10% for distribution, manufacturing, and retail; and 5% for testing laboratories, effective until amended or repealed, with estimated annual revenue of \$1,900,000 to \$52,800,000, be adopted?

### **Measure P (Countywide):**

Shall the measure allowing for outdoor and mixed-light (greenhouse) commercial cannabis cultivation for medicinal use on parcels of at least 10 acres zoned Rural Lands, Planned Agricultural, Limited Agricultural, and Agricultural Grazing that are restricted in canopy size, required to pay a County commercial cannabis tax, and subject to a site-specific review and discretionary permitting process with notification to surrounding property owners and environmental regulation be adopted?

### **Measure Q (Countywide):**

Shall the measure allowing for outdoor and mixed-light (greenhouse) commercial cannabis cultivation for recreational adult use on parcels of at least 10 acres zoned Rural Lands, Planned Agricultural, Limited Agricultural, and Agricultural Grazing that are restricted in canopy size, required to pay a County commercial cannabis tax, and subject to a site-specific review and discretionary permitting process with notification to surrounding property owners and environmental regulation be adopted?

**Measure R (Countywide):**

Shall the measure allowing for the retail sale, delivery, distribution, and indoor cultivation of commercial cannabis for medicinal use on parcels zoned Community Commercial, Regional Commercial, General Commercial, Industrial High, and Industrial Low that are restricted in number and concentration, required to pay a County commercial cannabis tax, and subject to a site-specific review and discretionary permitting process with notification to surrounding property owners and environmental regulation be adopted?

**Measure S (Countywide):**

Shall the measure allowing for the retail sale, delivery, distribution, and indoor cultivation of commercial cannabis for recreational adult use on parcels zoned Community Commercial, Regional Commercial, General Commercial, Industrial High, and Industrial Low that are restricted in number and concentration, required to pay a County commercial cannabis tax, and subject to a site-specific review and discretionary permitting process with notification to surrounding property owners and environmental regulation be adopted?
