APPLICANT STATEMENT OF AVAILABILITY

I am aware that service on the El Dorado County Civil Grand Jury is for a twelve-month period commencing July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, and that service will require my attendance at a minimum of two general meetings each month of the entire Grand Jury, in addition to intervening portions of one to three days a week devoted to committee meetings. The total time requirement can be as much as 40-50 hours a month. I understand that it is essential that all Grand Jury members attend all general meetings and only the most pressing emergency or illnesses are acceptable reasons for absence. Reasonable vacations are permissible with appropriate notice to the Foreperson. I am also aware that I will be required to be present for the impanelment proceedings in mid-June to early-July and expected to participate in a three half-day training sessions in June/July 2021. I hereby state that I am in good health, that I have no plans for vacation, travel, or business (other than those indicated earlier in this application) that would prevent me from serving the required amount of time.

I recognize that I have a duty to uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States and of California, and that my attendance and participation in good faith and in appropriate business attire will be expected and may be required by the Foreperson of the El Dorado County Civil Grand Jury.

I fully understand that by completing this application, a background check may be conducted.
