## **What is In-Home Supportive Services?**

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IHSS is a program that provides services to individuals on a limited income who need assistance in order to remain living in their home. IHSS is an alternative to out of home care providing domestic and personal care services to eligible IHSS recipients.

## **Who is Eligible?**

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You may be eligible for IHSS if you are:

- 65 years old, blind or disabled
- Receive SSI or are low income with low assets
- You are a U.S. citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- Live in a private residence
- Eligible to receive Medi-Cal

Note: There are specific eligibility requirements when a recipient has a spouse or is a child.

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## **What Services May Eligible Individual Receive?**

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IHSS recipients may receive personal care services such as bathing, grooming, dressing and toileting as well as domestic services such as cleaning, meal preparation, shopping and laundry. Services are authorized based on the individual functional needs and in accordance with program regulations.

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## **How Does IHSS Work?**

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The IHSS recipient is the employer of the care provider. IHSS will arrange payment once the care provider is hired by the recipient. The recipient is responsible for providing supervision and signing the provider's time sheets. Family and friends are encouraged to help in locating a provider. Relatives may be the care provider.

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
