Public Comment:

Public Comment on non-agenda items will be received at the designated place on the agenda. Individuals shall be allowed to speak once and will have a maximum of three (3) uninterrupted minutes to present their comment. It is the intent of the Commission on Aging to have additional flexibility depending upon the nature of the issue. Individual Commission members may ask clarifying questions but will not engage in substantive dialogue with person providing input to the Commission.

If a person providing input to the Commission creates a disruption by refusing to follow Commission guidelines, the Chair of the Commission may take the following actions:

1. Request the person adhere to the Commission guidelines. If the person refuses, the Chair may turn off the speaker's microphone.
2. If the disruption continues, the Chair may order a recess of the Commission meeting.
3. If the disruption continues, the Chair may order the removal of the person from the meeting.
