Name a Road

Created by a Land Division

Following is an outline for completing an application for naming a road created by a land division.

1. FORMS

- a. Obtain the **ROAD NAME PETITION** from the El Dorado County Surveyor.
- b. Fill out the form completely. Prior to obtaining signatures, call the County Surveyor's Office for tentative approval.

2. EXHIBIT MAP & TENTATIVE MAP

- a. Accurately plot the roads on an exhibit map.
- b. Provide a copy of the Approved Tentative Map.

3. SIGNATURES REQUIRED FOR APPROVAL

- a. The petition must be signed and approved by:
 - A minimum of **51%** of the parcel owners along a road being named.
 - A minimum of **75%** of the parcel owners along a road being changed.
 - The local fire department.
 - The post office responsible for mail delivery in your area. If no delivery is available, the approval of the closest post office.

4. PROCESSING

- a. County Surveyor reviews application for consistency with County Code and safety standards and practices.
- b. Applicant shall advise County Surveyor on the drivability of each road segment and provide gate codes as applicable.
- c. County Surveyor delineates roads on GIS Map.
- d. Applicant shall, within thirty days of notification, install a permanent sign for each road per County design standards.
- e. If the roads are not built at the time the Final Map is recorded, applicant shall notify the County Surveyor's Office when they are built and immediately install the required signage.
- f. County Surveyor forwards notification to appropriate agencies.

4. ADDRESSING

- a. Addresses will be assigned within thirty days after new Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) are assigned by the Assessor's Office.
- b. Applicant shall post new situs addresses within two weeks of notification, on any existing dwellings.
- c. Applicant shall post new situs addresses on new residential structures upon their completion.

NOTE: Address assignment and road mapping are dependent on the progress of the development and environmental factors.

FEES:

- \$300** **NEW ROAD** ~ Deposit covers first 2 hours. Additional time to be billed at a rate of \$100 per hour. Address fees may apply.
- \$200** **ROAD EXTENSION** ~ Deposit covers first 2 hours. Additional time to be billed at a rate of \$100 per hour. Address fees may apply.
- \$150** **EACH ROAD NAME**
- \$60** **SITUS ADDRESS ASSIGNMENT/CHANGE** ~ Deposit covers 1 hour. Additional time to be billed at a rate of \$100 per hour.

Applications typically take 2-4 weeks to approve, however, complex applications may take several months depending on the circumstances.

EL DORADO COUNTY'S POLICY ON ROAD NAMING

1. Standards - Street names and suffixes shall be selected in accordance with the following standards:
 - a. Street names shall be short (under 12 letters, if possible) and preferably in one word.
 - b. Street names should have a simple spelling and easy pronunciation.
 - c. Prefixes such as north and south, east and west, upper and lower, etc., should be avoided.
 - d. Suffixes shall be related to the type and importance of the street (e.g. the suffix "boulevard" should not be attached to the name of a minor residential street).
 - e. Numbers or letters used as street names shall be avoided.
 - f. Incongruous or offensive names shall not be selected.
 - g. Street names identical, or sounding similar, to other street names shall not be selected.
 - h. Street names shall be deemed duplicated regardless of a different suffix such as boulevard, lane, avenue, street, etc.
 - i. A cul-de-sac street may bear the same name as the street it intersects, providing that the suffix is "court" (e.g. a cul-de-sac opening on Oak Street may be called Oak Court).
 - j. Street names which would be geographically misleading shall be avoided.
 - k. Selection of street names of similar nature or according to categories (e.g. trees, states, etc.) is encouraged within a subdivision or neighborhood.
 - l. A street having a continuous alignment shall bear the same name.
 - m. Streets or portions of streets to be connected in the future into a continuous alignment shall bear the same name.
 - n. Streets intersecting each other or forming an angle of less than 110 degrees shall generally have different names.
 - o. Street extensions shall bear the same name as the existing streets.
 - p. Selection of the name and suffix of the streets in a new subdivision shall be up to the developer, within the above limitations.
 - q. No personal last names shall be selected unless they have historical significance as defined by Chapter 110.040.090.
