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## **EL DORADO COUNTY IMPLEMENTING TEMPORARY DETOUR OF AND TRAFFIC CONTROL OPERATIONS ON MALCOLM DIXON ROAD**

**October 4 through December 31, 2021**

El Dorado County's Department of Transportation, in conjunction with CTA Engineering & Surveying and GradeTek Inc., will be implementing a temporary road detour along Malcolm Dixon Road in El Dorado Hills beginning Monday, October 4th and continuing until approximately December 31, 2021. The detour will begin west of Clarinda Way and end east of Casa Robles Rd. Vehicles will be directed to use the temporary alignment while traveling through the construction zone.

The Malcolm Dixon Road detour will allow for the reconstruction of Malcolm Dixon Road and the construction of the new intersection at Malcolm Dixon Cutoff Road.

Reversing traffic control operations will be in place for a portion of the closure, with exact dates reflected by the on-site signage. The reversing control traffic operations will allow for the widening of Malcolm Dixon Road from west of Alta Vista Ct to the new intersection at Malcolm Dixon Cutoff Road.

Please check the County website for any further traffic control.

Motorists are advised to slow down through the work zone and expect delays during construction. Motorists are also advised to allow extra time when traveling through the work zone in order to arrive at their destinations on time or use alternate routes to avoid the construction area.

The County sincerely appreciates the cooperation and patience of motorists that use this roadway and we apologize for any inconvenience as a result of the temporary realignment.
