MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:

ADOPTION OF AGENDA & APPROVAL OF CONSENT

CALENDAR: At this time, the Committee may make any necessary additions, deletions or corrections to the agenda including moving items to or from the Consent Calendar and adopt the agenda and the Consent Calendar with one single vote. A Committee member may request an item be removed from the Consent Calendar for discussion and separate Board action. At the appropriate time as called by the Board Chair, members of the public may make a comment on matters on the Consent Calendar prior to Board action.

OPEN FORUM: Matters not on the consent Calendar may be addressed by the general public during the Open Forum. Individual comments are limited to three (3) minutes. “Protocols for Public Comment” shall follow the County’s Board of Supervisors adopted protocol from December 5, 2017 and February 26, 2019.

CONSENT CALENDAR: The Committee may approve any or all the following “Engineering and Traffic Surveys” in an omnibus approval. Items not approved in the omnibus Consent Calendar will be addressed separately by the Committee.

“ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC SURVEYS” on CONSENT CALENDAR:

1. Speed Zone Survey on Elks Club Drive from Pioneer Trail to US Hwy 50 (Study Length of 0.81 Miles):

Staff recommendation to retain the existing “30” and “40” MPH” speed limits with radar enforcement.

2. Speed Zone Survey on Golden Bear Trail from Pioneer Trail to its end (Study Length of 0.84 Miles):

Staff recommendation to retain the existing “35 MPH” speed limit with radar enforcement.

3. Speed Zone Survey on Lake Tahoe Boulevard from the North Upper Truckee Road easterly to the South Lake Tahoe city limits (Study Length 3.12 Miles):

Staff recommendation to retain the existing “35, 45, and 55 MPH” speed limits with radar enforcement.

4. Speed Zone Survey on Mt Rainer Drive from North Upper Truckee Road to Lake Tahoe Boulevard (Study Length 0.61Miles):

Staff recommendation to retain the existing “35 MPH” speed limit with radar enforcement.

5. Speed Zone Survey on Pioneer Trail from US Hwy 50 north to South Lake Tahoe city limits (Study Length 5.22 Miles):

Staff recommendation to retain the existing “40 and 50 MPH” speed limits with radar enforcement.

6. Speed Zone Survey on Sawmill Road from US Hwy 50 to Lake Tahoe Boulevard (Study Length 1.84 Miles):

Staff recommendation to retain the existing “45 MPH” speed limit with radar-enforcement.
