The Community Development Agency Environmental Management Department (EMD) and the County Health and Human Services Agency acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will evaluate the information provided. Please allow at least three business days for review.

If your request is approved, you will receive a Waste Tire Amnesty Event Hauler Exemption Approval Letter from the LEA.

Public Resources Code (PRC) §42954(a)(7): *PRC §42954 (a) A person who hauls waste or used tires is exempt from registration under this chapter if the following condition is met: (7) **The person who is not a waste tire generating business**, is transporting waste or used tires to an amnesty day event or to a waste tire disposal site that lawfully accepts waste tires for disposal, and has received written Authorization specifying conditions for that hauling for one day from the local enforcement agency.*

Conditions of Exemption

1. You must receive a Waste Tire Amnesty Event Hauler Exemption Approval Letter from the LEA before transporting waste tires to an approved collection event. The exemption letter must be presented to any peace officer or authorized agent of El Dorado County or CalRecycle.
2. Transport shall occur in a safe manner which may include the use of tie down ropes or cover tarps to prevent tires from being ejected on to the roadways.
3. Waste tire piles are known to harbor dangerous snakes, spiders, rodents, mosquitoes, rancid water, and mud. Be cautious when loading tires.
4. This authorization is only valid for the date of transportation to an approved Waste Tire Amnesty Collection Event. Routine events will be held the 3rd Saturday of each month until grant funds have been exhausted. See EMD's website (<http://www.edcgov.us/EMD/>) for more information.
5. No waste tires from businesses will be accepted. No more than 20 waste tires can be transported at a time. No tires greater than 24" in diameter will be accepted.
