Only approved recycling facilities listed here will be granted "recycling or reuse" credit toward the diversion requirement. Effective 1/1/2017, CalGreen increases the mandated minimum diversion rate for C&D projects from 50% to 65%.

If you believe that the C&D Management Facility you plan to use should be an "Approved Recycling Facility", you're welcome to submit a justification statement to Environmental Management for review. On the first page, select "other" as the C&D debris management facility for the debris type and write/type the facility name into the field. Attach to your Waste Management Plan a justification including the facility name, address, phone number, and description of the debris you plan to take there. EMD will contact the facility and review their business operations to determine if they meet the recycling diversion requirements. This may delay your Waste Management Plan review time.

If a franchise hauler will be used, it must be the franchise hauler local to the area the project is taking place. A map of franchise areas is included in the WMP Guidelines packet and can be found on-line at:
