



PUBLIC REVIEW DRAFT CLIMATE VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT

The County of El Dorado Draft Climate Vulnerability Assessment (CVA) is available for public review. The County invites you to participate in our second Public Workshop.

The Draft CVA was developed to support the County's General Plan Public Health, Safety, and Noise Element (Safety Element) update. It is based on the latest climate science and incorporates local data and projections to provide a comprehensive understanding of our region's vulnerability to climate change. Residents, organizations, businesses, and stakeholders are encouraged to contribute to the planning process by reviewing and providing feedback on the Draft CVA. The public review period will be open for 20 days from May 2, 2023 to May 21, 2023.
