REQUIRED SUBMITTAL INFORMATION for SUPPLEMENTAL SUBMITTAL INFORMATION FOR COMMERCIAL CANNABIS TESTING LABORATORIES

The following supplemental information must be provided with all applications for Commercial Cannabis Testing Laboratory facilities. If all the information is not provided, the application will be deemed incomplete and will not be accepted.

Transportation Procedures:

Describes how the applicant proposes to ensure cannabis is transported securely. If the applicant will not transport cannabis they must state that they will be contracting for transportation.

Inventory Procedures:

Describes how the applicant will receive shipments of cannabis, store its cannabis inventory, perform inventory reconciliation, ensure inventory records are accurate, and maintain records of the inventory.

ISO/IEC 17025 Accreditation:

Testing laboratories must obtain and maintain ISO/IEC 17025 accreditation. Acceptable accreditation must attest to the testing laboratory's competence to perform testing of the following: Cannabinoids, heavy metals, microbial impurities, mycotoxins, residual pesticides, residual solvents and processing chemicals and terpenoids (if tested).

Testing Methods – Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs):

Procedures for the following testing methods must be provided: Cannabinoids, foreign material, heavy metals, microbial impurities, moisture content and water activity, mycotoxins, residual pesticides, residual solvents and processing chemicals, terpenoids (if tested) and homogeneity (if tested).
