Rebuilding After a Disaster

Rebuilding after a disaster can be an emotional, tiring and slow process. The Community Development Agency has systems in place to try and ensure a smooth process. We try to summarize this process below.

During the disaster:

 Disaster tracking numbers are created on all parcels with improvements and located within boundaries of the disaster.

After the disaster area access has been deemed safe:

- Teams of two building professionals will conduct a rapid evaluation on all structures within the disaster boundaries.
- Information gained from the rapid evaluation will be documented under the disaster tracking number for that parcel.
- Research will be conducted noting the number of structures involved on the parcel, type of structures (use), size and permit history.
- Owners should obtain a demolition permit for each structure needing demolishing. This will ensure full square footage and development credits are applied to the parcel.
- Call to schedule all required field inspections during the demolition of your structure(s) (530) 621-5377
- You may qualify for placement of a temporary hardship mobile home (TMA) on your parcel.
 This would enable you to live temporary in a mobile home while you rebuild your property.

When you are ready to start the rebuild process:

- Complete the permit application http://edcgov.us/Government/Building/Forms.aspx
- Prepare your plans and documentation per plan review guidelines. http://edcgov.us/Government/Building/Handouts_Checklists.aspx
- Submit your application, plans and documentation to any Building Services office location http://edcgov.us/Government/DevServices/Contact_Information_and_Office_Hours.aspx
- Your application and plans will be reviewed under our expedited plan reviews program. This program allows rebuilding projects within a disaster area be moved to the front of the review list.
- Once permit approval notification has been received, obtain your building permit(s).
- Start the reconstruction of your building(s).
