There will be over 75 positions available on various local schools, fire, airport, recreation, utility districts and community services districts in El Dorado County this November. Candidate filing for these positions will open July 15, 2013 and close August 9, 2013. Citizens interested in serving and who are registered voters are qualified to run for local office.

A candidate for Mc Kinney Water District must be a landowner within the district. A candidate for the El Dorado Irrigation District must be a registered voter within the Division of the District.

Declaration of Candidacy papers for Mc Kinney Water District may only be obtained at Placer County Elections Division, located in the De Witt Center at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn. Hours of operation are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday excluding holidays.

Declaration of candidacy papers will be available beginning Monday, July 15, in the County Elections Department. A list of offices scheduled for election is available on the Elections Department website at www.edcgov.us/elections
