

**NOTICE OF ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2013**

**MARBLE MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
ROAD IMPROVEMENT ZONE "2"  
MEASURE C**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** to the qualified electors of the Marble Mountain Community Services District, Road Improvement Zone "2", that the Board of Directors has called for an election to be held on November 5, 2013.

"Shall the Board of Directors of the Marble Mountain CSD be authorized to annually assess each parcel located within the Road Improvement Zone "2" within the District an amount up to, but not exceeding \$400.00, for the maintenance and improvement of roadways within Road Improvement Zone "2", and other lawful purposes of the District?"

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that this measure shall be called **Measure C**.

**Arguments for and against this measure** may be submitted between the dates of **Friday, July 19, 2013 and Thursday, July 25, 2013 at 5:00 p.m.** **Primary arguments** for and against this measure **shall not exceed 300 words** in length and shall not be accepted unless accompanied by the name(s) and address(es) of the person(s) submitting it. **Person turning in an argument MUST be a registered voter in the district.** **No more than five signatures** shall appear with any argument and original signatures are necessary.

**BE FURTHER ADVISED** that **rebuttal arguments for or against** said measure must be submitted **no later than Thursday, August 1, 2013.** Rebuttal arguments **shall not exceed 250 words** in length and follow the same laws as primary arguments with regard to names, signatures and argument submission. All arguments and rebuttals must be **submitted in person, or by certified mail** to the Registrar of Voters, Elections Department, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA 95667.

The Elections Department shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 5, 2013. The ballots will be counted beginning at 8:00 p.m. following the closing of the polls, at the Elections Department, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville. The public is invited to observe.
