Consolidated Districts Election Nov. 3, 2015

As November 3, 2015 approaches, there will be a Uniform District Election titled "Consolidated Districts Election". This is a local, county election for special districts, measures and initiatives. We began mailing Sample Ballot information mailers on Sept. 29th, and October 5 commences the Vote by Mail mailing period. We will begin processing returned Vote by Mail ballots on October 20th, and all observers are welcome. October 27th is the final day for applying for a Vote by Mail ballot. The Vote by Mail Drop Off box in front of Bldg. C will be available beginning October 5th.

Pilot program will be conducted for Rosters at Polling places.

During the Nov. 3, 2015 election, a new process for poll workers and voters will be tested, using an Electronic Tablet in addition to the paper roster for signing in when voting at the polls. Your usual signing of the paper roster will still be done, but in addition, we will be checking you in on the electronic tablet roster. It should only be a minute at most longer to complete this process. I thank you ahead of time for your cooperation and patience. BE SURE TO VOTE NOV. 3, 2015. NOTE: Not all registered voters will be voting during this election, since it is only for local districts that have candidates or measures on the ballot.
