Z04-0015/S01-0011/P08-0036/Springs Equestrian Center submitted by DENNIS GRAHAM (Agent: Casey Feickert/TSD Engineering) for the following: 1) Rezone from Estate Residential Five-Acre (RE-5)/Estate Residential (RE-10) to Recreational Facilities (RF); 2) Tentative Parcel Map to create two parcels, 45.77 acres and 100.65 acres in size; and 3) Special Use Permit for an equestrian facility with two covered arenas 45,000 square feet each, stall barns for 420 horses, five fenced riding areas, 19,600 square-foot equestrian retail store/office/clubhouse, guest cottages, camping for horse trailers during events, special events with up to 250 spectators, and a 32 square-foot lighted monument sign is proposed. The property, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 115-410-05, consisting of 146.42 acres, is located on the south side of Green Valley Road, at the intersection with Deer Valley Road, in the Rescue area, Supervisorial District 1.
