The **County of El Dorado Planning Commission** will hold a public hearing in the Building C Hearing Room, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA 95667 on **July 28, 2016**, at **8:30 a.m.**, to consider the following: **Tentative Subdivision Map Time Extension TM08-1473-E/Cameron Hills Tentative Subdivision Map** submitted by MCP PROPERTIES, LLC to request six one-year time extensions to the approved Cameron Hills Tentative Subdivision Map creating 41 detached residential lots, resulting in a new expiration date of July 21, 2022. The property, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 116-010-04, consisting of 20.13 acres, is located approximately 800 feet west of Cambridge Road, north of Knollwood Drive, in the Cameron Park area, Supervisorial District 2.
