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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The **County of El Dorado Planning Commission** will hold a public hearing in the Building C Hearing Room, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA 95667 on **February 9, 2017**, at **8:30 a.m.**, to consider **Special Use Permit Revision S87-0057-R/Cameron Park CSD Rasmussen Park** submitted by CAMERON PARK COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT (CSD) for a revision to the approved Cameron Park Community Service District special use permit to allow operation of an existing T-ball field, installation of a bocce ball court, and the construction of an eight-foot solid wood fence at an existing community park. The property, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 083-466-10, consisting of 10 acres, is located on the east side of Mira Loma Drive, at the terminus of Monukka Drive, in the Cameron Park area, Supervisorial District 4.
