### Agenda

The purpose of this meeting is to meet for discussion as requested by members of PAWTAC.

1. Discuss INRMP RFP next steps.
2. Committee – open discussion of topics submitted for agenda listing:
  - a. Is the RFP going to be released before the meeting date? I think it would be good to have the PAWTAC involved peripherally in reviewing the scopes of work and consultant qualifications, to be able to provide some feedback to the County.
  - b. The process for selection of the consultant; whether to include large expanses of native vegetation other than oak woodland PCAs on the Initial Inventory and Mapping; PAWTAC/ISAC involvement in the identification and prioritization of potential connections among protected areas and important habitat.
  - c. Has the county determined who would participate in the interview process? I know last time I participated, but the full PAWTAC/ISAC groups are too large now to effectively participate so I would suggest potentially have each group appoint one or two participants to sit on the panel if you county wishes to have their participation.
  - d. I'm not sure of the urgency of any topic this month over next month, but certainly if there is interest in being part of the RFP review process that should be kicked around early on so that the County can decide how it wants to treat that interest.
