The Planning Department cannot guarantee that any FAX or mail received the day of the hearing will be delivered to the Zoning Administrator prior to any action.

It is important that the applicant or applicant's representative attend the hearing no later than 10:00 A.M., as agenda items may be heard out of order and hearings often proceed quickly. If attendance is not possible, the project planner should be contacted prior to the hearing.

All Zoning Administrator hearings are tape recorded. Anyone wishing to purchase a recorded tape for \$5.00 may do so by contacting the Planning Department after action has been taken.

- a. **VA04-25 – BRIAN BAKKEN:** Pursuant to County Code Section 10.16, a public hearing shall be held on the appeal of notice of intention to abate and remove vehicle(s) or part(s) thereof as public nuisance, located at 4693 Church Street in El Dorado, California.

ACTION: The Zoning Administrator continued this item to the hearing date of December 15, 2004.

- b. **VA04-26 – THERESA BURCH:** Pursuant to County Code Section 10.16, a public hearing shall be held on the appeal of notice of intention to abate and remove vehicle(s) or part(s) thereof as public nuisance, located at 4701 Church Street in El Dorado, California.

ACTION: The Zoning Administrator continued this item to the hearing date of December 15, 2004.

- c. **VA04-27 – JOYCE HALL:** Pursuant to County Code Section 10.16, a public hearing shall be held on the appeal of notice of intention to abate and remove vehicle(s) or part(s) thereof as public nuisance, located at 5695 Pony Express Trail in Cedar Grove, California.

ACTION: The Zoning Administrator approved the appeal, determining that subject vehicle is abandoned and declared said vehicle to be a public nuisance, and ordered its removal with abatement cost to be the responsibility of the property owner.

- d. **VA04-38 - AUTOWEST DODGE, CHRYSLER, PLYMOUTH, JEEP:** Pursuant to County Code Section 10.16, a public hearing shall be held on the appeal of notice of intention to abate and remove vehicle(s) or part(s) thereof as public nuisance, located at 6565 Runnymede Drive in Diamond Springs, California.

ACTION: The Zoning Administrator approved the appeal, determining that subject vehicle is abandoned and declared said vehicle to be a public nuisance, and ordered its removal with abatement cost to be the responsibility of the property owner.

5. **CONTINUED PROJECTS** (Public Hearing)

- a. **COC04-75 – WILLIAM KEARNS:** Certificate of Compliance for a five-acre parcel created by grant deed on May 25, 1972, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 105-190-22, zoned Estate Residential Five-Acre (RE-5), located on the east side of Old Ranch Road, approximately 0.90 mile north of the intersection with Luneman Road in the Rescue area. Approval of the certificate relates only to issues of compliance or noncompliance with the Subdivision Map Act and local ordinances enacted pursuant thereto. The parcel described herein may be sold,

leased, or financed without further compliance with the Subdivision Map Act or any local ordinance enacted pursuant thereto. Development of the parcel may require issuance of a permit or permits, or other grant or grants of approval. (Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared)*
